The following policies constitute our Standards of Care:

- Vaccine/flea policy:** In order for pets to board they must be current on their rabies, distemper, and kennel cough vaccines (required every 6 months) Pets must also have had a fecal test within the past year that shows that they do not have intestinal parasites. Pets that are not current on these vaccines will have an examination and be vaccinated upon arrival. If a pet is found to have intestinal parasites, they will be treated for them. Any pet found with fleas, will be treated with Frontline. These charges will be added to the boarding fees.
- Exercise policy:** All dogs will be taken outside 2-3 times daily.
- Emergency Care Policy:** In case of emergency Companion Animal Hospital is authorized to treat animals in our care.
- Belongings policy:** We will do our best to return all items brought in at the time of boarding however, Companion Animal Hospital is not responsible for any lost or damaged items.
